

KOMEGA REQUIREMENTS: Multi Group Management

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Abstract

Introducing the management of multiple groups working with different projects in parallel.

1 Multiple Projects

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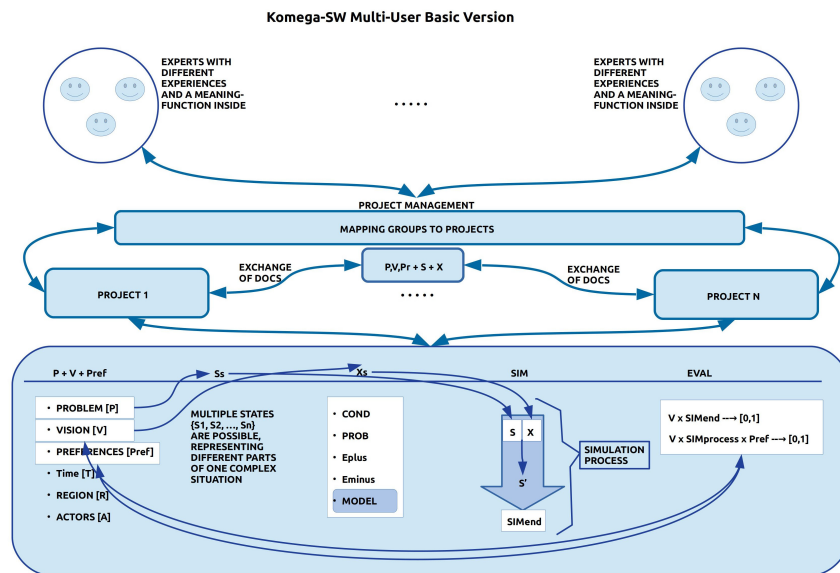


Figure 1: Multiple projects in parallel run by different groups

In everyday working there will usually exist more than one group using the komega-SW to plan and analyze a project. Figure 1 gives a rough outline of this case.

The main *requirement* for the komega platform is that more than one group can be logged in with separate projects. Every group can edit their own documents including several problem - vision - Preferences [P-V-Pr] documents associated with appropriate state [S] and change [X] documents.

To allow *transfer of knowledge* between the different groups it is possible to *share the PVPR-S-X documents* between the groups in a format which allows direct usage in the projects of the other groups.
